Racing Rules & Information

* CAR CLASSES:

- A. Vintage British Sports Cars - stock
- B. All Sports Cars - non-race cars
- C. Stock Race Cars - not street legal
- D. Prepared Race - any type of car, any modification allowed, including open-wheel cars

* Tech Inspection will determine class

RACE RULES:

1. Classes A, B & C - Silicone tires and one additional magnet allowed.
2. All races will be run by Class with 5 to 10 laps on each lane. The number of laps will be determined by over-all track length.
3. In case of an odd number of entries in any given class, the race host will run as a pace challenger for the extra car. The host member will *not* receive an official time in this race.
4. All drivers will use the "house" speed controllers (or the same speed controllers, if substitution is necessary.)
5. Participants may register only one entry in each class. However, the same car may be entered in more than one class.
6. Participants will pay a \$5.00 driver fee for each Class in which they register a car. This fee will cover all 4 race nights.
7. All drivers in a Class are expected to work a corner during the following class session, and fill in for other sessions as needed. *Example:* Class A drivers work the Class B session, etc. Class D drivers will work the Class A session.
8. Drivers must be at least 18 years of age.
9. **NO liquids or food will be allowed on the track table, or in the hands of drivers or corner workers!**
10. All protests will be filed in the septic field!

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Practice sessions will begin at 7:00 pm. Racing begins promptly at 8:00 pm. Drivers must be "ready to race" when their heat is announced or risk time penalties.

The race host is responsible for the track, timing devices & speed controllers and will also supply some snack foods. Participants and spectators will supply their own beverages, and may also bring snacks or hors d'oeuvres to share with the group.
