Sunday, September 20, 2009 marks a milestone year for the City of Trenton, Wayne County Parks and the annual Somewhere in Time event. From 11 a.m.—5 p.m. in Wayne County's Elizabeth Park, Trenton will celebrate it's 175th Birthday and Wayne County will celebrate it's 90th Birthday as the hands of time are turned back to the early 1900's, during the 25th annual "Somewhere in Time". This unique event, is designed to recapture the flavor of this bygone era in our history.

We would like to invite you to join us for this monumental occasion by displaying your vintage antique car as part of a special display commemorating this unique time in our history. In keeping with the flavor of the event, only vintage antique cars will be allowed to participate. No muscle cars or hot rods are eligible.

The event will be open to all vintage antique cars up to the year 1983 to create a "Walk through Automotive Time." In order to keep the early 1900's atmosphere for the event, those cars produced earlier than 1954 will be displayed in the main event area. Later model years will be prominently displayed in chronological order in a special area that will take visitors on a "Walk through Automotive Time". We also encourage you to really get in the spirit of things by dressing in vintage clothing.

As you can see, the day will be filled with activities reminiscent of this era.

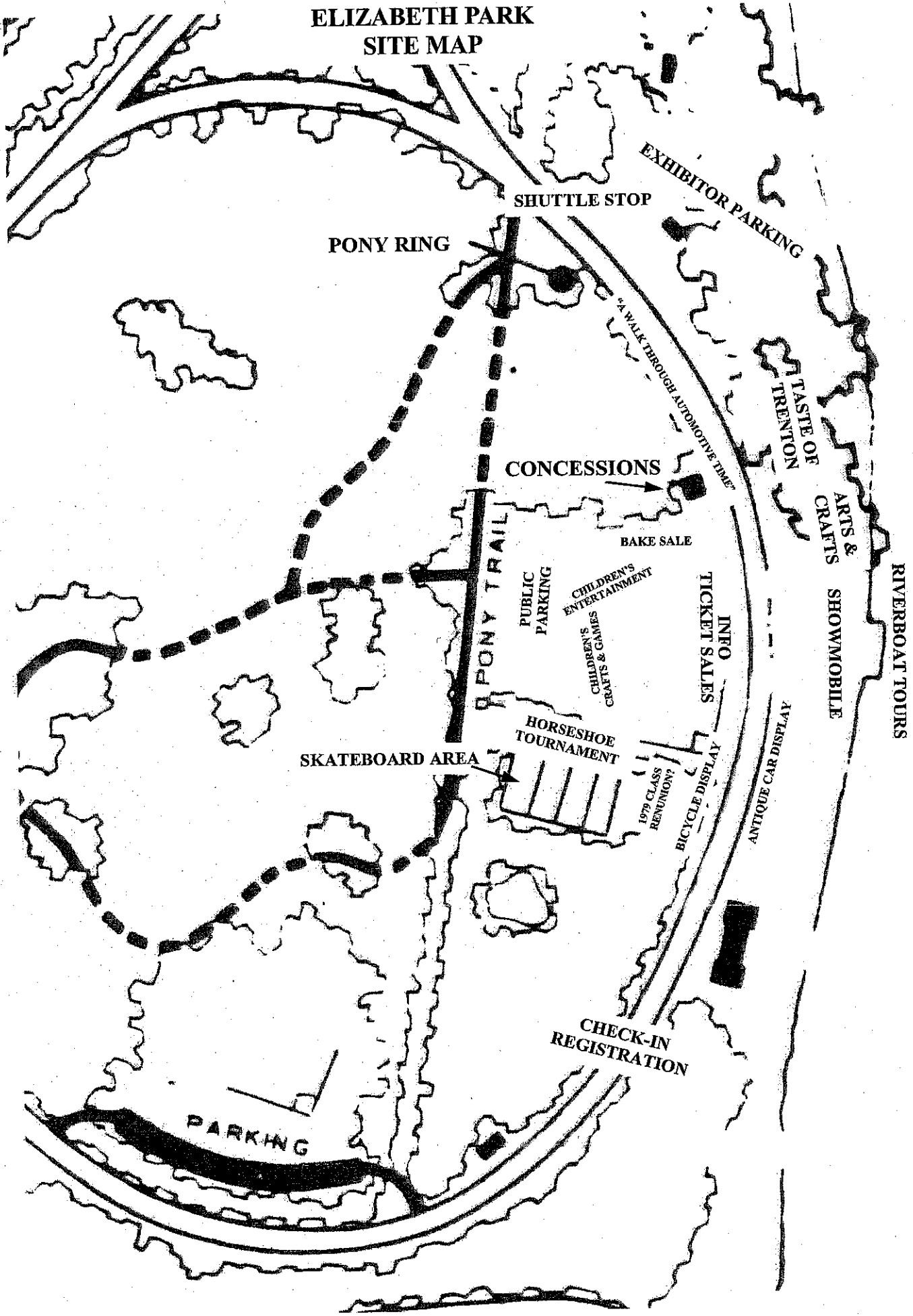
